Safety at the field.

There has been several safety related issues noted the past few weeks. It is the responsibility of every member to watch and monitor for dangerous activities. We all will make mistakes and as such we must be willing to accept warnings from club members when infractions or concerns occur. We can't make rules for every situation. If so we

couldn't fly for all the rule signs, etc.

Following are some of the situations that have been observed.

Smoking while fueling of models.
Gasoline is much more explosive than glow fuel but both will ignite and gasoline with much more spectacular results. Use common sense. Fueling is to be done at the flight line or starting stands not under the shelter.

Taxing any model in the pit area.
The model is under radio control and Murphy's law is always there to cause loss of control with an engine or motor going to full power and racing across the infield doing serious damage. The club rule is you must have physical restraint of your model as long as it is behind the gates leading to the runway. The engine is to be shut off when the model comes into the taxiway after flying and before it passes the safety fence.

Do not start takeoff runs if anyone is on the runway side of the safety fence.

Please use a spotter who is responsible for watching for other aircraft both in the air and on the runway. Announce your intentions per the rules posted on the safety fence.

The club has enacted the 98 db sound rule as of June 1 of this year. Several models are flying with Propellers that are generating excessive noise. If this continues written warning will be issued and no flying permitted until issue resolved. We do not want to be a Gestapo regarding this. You know if your plane is too loud and if you don't want to resolve the problem please take your flying somewhere else.

This is a hobby for the enjoyment of all club members and nobody wants to see injuries occur.



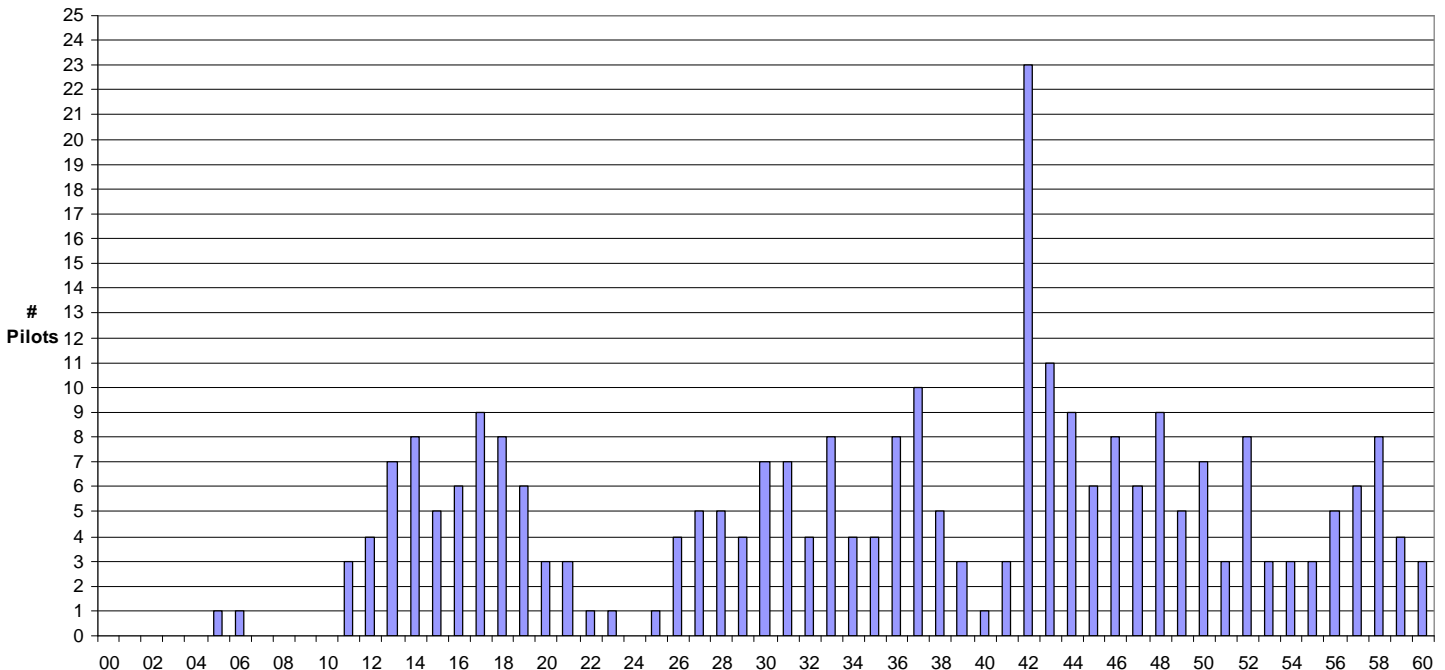
